

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- I. Rules and Regulations for the Government of Water Utilities, adopted by the Public Service Commission of West Virginia, and now in effect, and all amendments thereto and modifications thereof hereafter made by said Commission.

STEP 2 RATES
(Effective after 24 months)

SCHEDULE No. 1

APPLICABILITY

Applicable in Cottageville, Jackson County (Low Level)

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial service

(D) **RATES** (customers with metered water supply)

First	3,000 gallons used per month	\$7.30 per 1,000 gallons
Next	3,000 gallons used per month	\$6.71 per 1,000 gallons
Next	4,000 gallons used per month	\$6.01 per 1,000 gallons
All Over	10,000 gallons used per month	\$4.74 per 1,000 gallons

(D) **MINIMUM CHARGE**

No bill shall be rendered for less than the following amounts, according to the meter installed, to-wit:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 21.90 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 32.85 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 54.75 per month
1 - 1/2 inch meter	\$ 109.50 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 175.20 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 350.04 per month
4 inch meter	\$ 547.50 per month
6 inch meter	\$1,095.00 per month
8 inch meter	\$1,752.00 per month

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above schedule is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.

SCHEDULE No. 1 (Continued)

TAP FEE

The following charge is to be made whenever the utility installs a new tap to serve an applicant. A tap fee of \$350.00 will be charged to customers applying for service outside of a certificate proceeding before the Commission for each new tap to the system.

RECONNECTION - \$25.00

To be charged whenever the supply of water is turned off for violations of rules, non-payment of bills or fraudulent use of water.

(D) PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE

Where connections, hydrants, sprinklers, etc., on private property are maintained by consumer:

2-inch connection	\$ 5.79 per month
4-inch connection	\$23.14 per month
6-inch connection	\$57.85 per month
8-inch connection	\$86.77 per month

INCREMENT LEAK ADJUSTMENT

\$0.50 per 1,000 gallons is to be used when the bill reflects unusual consumption which can be attributed to eligible leakage on the customer's side of the meter. This rate shall be applied to all consumption above the customer's historical usage.

RETURNED CHECK CHARGE

A service charge equal to the actual bank fee assessed to the water utility, not to exceed \$25.00, will be imposed upon any customer whose check for payment of charges is returned by their bank due to insufficient funds.

APPLICABILITY

Applicable in Jackson County and in Cologne and Cooper District in Mason County (Mt. Alto-Evergreen Hills-Booster Level, Millwood and Flatwoods).

AVAILABILITY

Available for general domestic, commercial and industrial service

(D) **RATES**

First	3,000 gallons used per month	\$8.28 per 1,000 gallons
Next	3,000 gallons used per month	\$7.65 per 1,000 gallons
Next	4,000 gallons used per month	\$6.77 per 1,000 gallons
All Over	10,000 gallons used per month	\$6.33 per 1,000 gallons

(D) **MINIMUM CHARGE**

No bill shall be rendered for less than the following amounts according to the meter installed, to-wit:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 24.84 per month
3/4 inch meter	\$ 37.26 per month
1 inch meter	\$ 62.10 per month
1 - 1/2 inch meter	\$ 124.20 per month
2 inch meter	\$ 198.72 per month
3 inch meter	\$ 397.44 per month
4 inch meter	\$ 621.00 per month
6 inch meter	\$1,242.00 per month
8 inch meter	\$1,987.20 per month

DELAYED PAYMENT PENALTY

The above scheduled is net. On all accounts not paid in full when due, ten percent (10%) will be added to the net current amount unpaid. This delayed payment penalty is not interest and is to be collected only once for each bill where it is appropriate.
